## ***New York State Coalition for the Aging Inc.'s 2003 Senior Services Achievements Awards***

### **Purpose**

To honor outstanding, innovative and creative Senior Services and Programs that have a long range impact on senior citizens and the community

### **Categories**

**A. Health Promotion/Wellness-** Services and Programs that educate, evaluate and/or monitor the physical and/or mental status of senior citizens.

**Corporate Supporter: Dignity Memorial**

**B. Community Partnerships -** Services and Programs that are benefiting senior citizens conducted in cooperation with another group or individual representing either the public or private sector.

**Corporate Supporter: JPMorganChase**

**C. Seniors and Technology -** Programs involving seniors and some aspect of technology which is making an impact on their lives.

**Corporate Supporter: The New York State Funeral Directors Association**

### **Eligibility**

An eligible agency must be a community focal point where older adults come together for information, services and activities. The program must clearly respond to a community need and be able to be replicated. Agency staff must have been actively involved in program planning and development. Volunteer participation is recommended. The program should be creative and innovative. *Previously submitted non-winning programs may be resubmitted.*

### **Nomination Process**

***A nomination form is on our website - [www.coalitionforaging.org](http://www.coalitionforaging.org).*** It may be duplicated as necessary. Agencies may self nominate with the approval of the agency's administrator. Agencies do not have to be members of NYSCA. Nominations due ***Friday, September 5, 2003.***

### **Judging**

Entries will be judged by a committee. The committee will be appointed by the New York State Coalition for the Aging, Inc. One program will be chosen as the winner for each of the categories.

### **Timetable**

Nominations must be **received in the NYSCA Office by Friday, September 5, 2003.**

Winning programs will be announced in our Fall Newsletter.

Award presentation will take place in November, 2003, at NYSCA's 4th Honorary Benefit Reception in Queens NY.
